GENERAL INFORMATION

- Sumner County Board of Education policy states that none of the eleven subjects required for graduation may be taken for the first time during the summer school session unless the student has maintained a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 or its equivalent. Students who have a grade point average of at least 2.0 or its equivalent and wish to take a subject required for graduation for the first time, must receive permission from the principal of the school the student regularly attends.
- Transportation is not provided.
- Absences (not to exceed five) **must** be made up in order to meet the required number of hours for credit. A **cash fee** of \$20 must be paid to make up each full absence (\$10 for a half day). Three tardies will be counted a full absence. Students arriving after 7:45 will be considered absent for a half day. Absences are to be made up immediately following the absence.
- Students must be picked up promptly at dismissal time.

REFUNDS

No money will be refunded after registration.

COST Payment is due at the time of registration. Cash only after May 30.

Fee waivers are accepted. You must present a copy of your waiver at the time of registration.
