#### WHAT IS TITLE I?

The purpose of the Title I, Part A program is to provide federal dollars to supplement educational opportunities for student who attend schools with high numbers or percentages of children from low-income families and are most at risk of failing to meet the state's challenging academic achievement standards. Title I, Part A funds are to be used to provide all students significant opportunity to receive a fair, equitable, and high-quality education, and to close educational achievement gaps.

## WHAT IS FAMILY ENGAGMENT?

Family engagement is the participation of family members in regular and meaningful communication involving student academic learning and other school activities. Family engagement also means families are partners with schools and are included in educational decisions of their child. Sumner County Schools believe families play an integral role in their child's learning.

#### STRENGTHENING OUR SCHOOLS

The District Federal Programs Department will assist and support all Title I schools in meeting family engagement requirements and implementing strategies. These schools will also receive information and resources from the district to enhance family engagement efforts. In addition to regular communication and school visits, the district will conduct meetings and training sessions with Title I school leadership to assess and refine family engagement plans and activities.

#### RESERVATION OF FUNDS

SCS sets aside one percent of its annual Title I funds to meet parent and family engagement requirements outlined in Section 1116 of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA).

Additionally, 90 percent of this allocation is distributed to Title I schools to support their local family engagement initiatives. The district will provide guidance to help each school develop a family engagement budget based on needs assessments and family input.

Each Title I school will hold an annual Spring Planning Meeting for families to contribute ideas on how to utilize these funds in the upcoming year. Feedback from comment cards, meetings, and family and staff surveys will inform the district's decisions regarding areas of need and potential adjustments to the family engagement budget for the next school year.

To enhance family engagement, SCS collaborates with family representatives from each Title I school, along with community stakeholders.
