Tutoring to Support High School Students in Daily Instruction


High School students may also be offered tutoring opportunities before and/or after school. Teachers may choose to be a tutor and will be compensated for their time.

- Before and/or after school opportunities
 - o Purpose: help with general questions, reteaching opportunities, review tests
 - Any student needing help may participate
 - o Teachers wanting to review tests, reteach skills, etc to a number of students may invite students to stay after school in the lab and get paid for that ho
 - Opportunities for 2 ELA and 2 Math at each school
- Cambridge ACT prep program
- Paper program
